CITY OF MARINA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION SEAT EXPIRING FEBRUARY 2010 AVAILABLE

The City of Marina is seeking interested individuals to fill one (1) seat on the Economic Development Commission, with a term expiring in February 2010, applications are due Monday, October 12, 2009.

The Economic Development Commission is an advisory body to the City Council regarding economic development in the City; downtown vitalization; and ways to encourage business to locate and remain in Marina. The Commission meets at 6:30 p.m. on the first Thursday of each month.

Interested individuals must be residents and registered voters of the City of Marina. While the City accepts applications for all Advisory Boards throughout the year, individuals interested in being eligible to interview for this Economic Development Commission seat, must submit the application before the filing deadline of 5:00 P.M., Monday, October 12, 2009.

Interviews will be conducted by an Interview Panel consisting of Mayor Bruce Delgado and City Council Liaison Member, Jim Ford. Final approval of appointments by the City Council is tentatively scheduled for a City Council meeting in November.
